




COVID-19 Information

COVID-19 is a new (novel) coronavirus that's known to spread thru coughing & sneezing, close contact (hugging, shaking hands, etc.), and surface contact. First identified within China in Dec. 2019, COVID-19 has rapidly spread on a global scale. People with the highest risk of severe illness from COVID-19 are the elderly, and any individual with underlying medical conditions. If you have any of the 3 main symptoms (coughing, fever, shortness of breath), it's important to first quarantine yourself & seek medical attention. Symptoms can appear from 2-14 days after initial exposure. See the next page for preventative tips.


