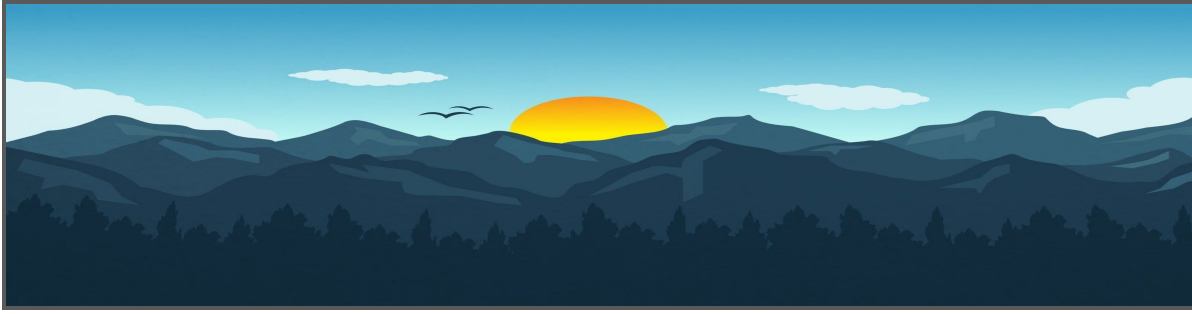


## Site Council Minutes, 09/23/19

- ❖ **Community and Staff Present** - Drasida Basargin, Lorne Carroll, Evdokaya Basargin, Kiril Basargin, Fenya Basargin, Kcenia Reutov, Efimia Basargin, Daria Basargin, Stephanida Basargin, Domnika Basargin, Severian Basargin, Aaron Walbrecher, Jane Beck
- ❖ **Welcome- sign-in**
- ❖ **Dates to Remember** – Reviewed upcoming dates on the school calendar.
- ❖ **Teacher Introductions** – New teachers were introduced to the Site Council: Michael Sturm as the new Middle & High School ELA/SS teacher, and Teresa Wishart as the new K/1 teacher. In addition, returning teachers and classified were introduced, along with open positions yet to be fulfilled.
- ❖ **Public Health Nurse** – Aaron Walbrecher and Lorne Carroll gave a presentation about available health services to the village. Several attendees asked clarifying questions
- ❖ **GED Presentation** - Shawn Story introduced GED Class opportunities available to the community, and requested that the word be spread amongst other villagers in Razdolna
- ❖ **Migrant Presentation** - Laura Murphy introduced Migrant plans for Head-of-Bay (HOB) Schools (Raz/Voz/Selo). This includes swim lesson trainings for both Elementary and MS/HS students, as well as a Driver's Ed course. Future trips and supports were currently being planned, and will be introduced at a later date.
- ❖ **Project GRAD** - Jane Beck presented a plan for STEAM Team for the FY20 School Year, and responded to some questions posed by several parents.
- ❖ **Title I** - Greg Melvin, Principal/Title I Teacher, provided the following discussion points over Title I
  - Overview of Title I Services at Razdolna School
  - Selection Process of Title I Students
  - Title I Brochure Review
  - How to request teacher qualifications
  - How to provide input/volunteer
- ❖ **Student-Parent Handbook Briefing & Feedback** - covered by Greg Melvin
  - Cell Phones - discussed updated cell phone policy, which all parents appeared to support based off their comments and feedback. Cell phones would be kept in designated sleeves at all times when students were in the classroom. No student will be allowed cell phones during instructional hours, other than when allowed for specific activities as designated by the teacher.
  - Late/Attendance Policy - discussed that any students arriving late must first check-in with the office prior to arriving in class. This is largely due to historical class skipping without parental awareness.



RoboCalls - due to frequent late arrivals of students, without parent awareness, decision was made to notify parents via PowerSchool RoboCalls whenever their child arrived late, or was counted absent, without such being excused. Reasons for excusal were discussed with parents.
